IMPROVING CANCER CARE WITH ON-SITE TESTING

The Ralph Lauren Center for Cancer Care is a nonprofit treatment center in Harlem, New York, dedicated to providing high-quality cancer care to all in need. Founded in 2000 by Dr. Harold Freeman with the combined resources of Polo Ralph Lauren Foundation and the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, the center offers preventive, diagnosis, and treatment services for most cancer types with a special focus on breast health services, lung cancer screenings and preventative care.

THE CHALLENGE

Most of the patients served by the Ralph Lauren Center are very sick and present co-morbidities. Each day, between 10 and 15 patients receive chemotherapy treatment and diagnostic tests must be performed to determine the patient's health status prior to inform treatment plans.* This meant sending patients to a commercial laboratory for testing. According to Lisa Pfail, Director of Clinical Services for the Ralph Lauren Center, this created a problem. "The turnaround time for test results was 24 hours. It wasn't convenient for the patient and we never knew when we would see the patients again," she explains.

THE SOLUTION

To address this problem and improve patient care, the Ralph Lauren Center decided to institute onsite testing capability with the Piccolo Xpress® chemistry analyzer.
